



RACE MEET 2023 NEWS

The Horsemen's entrance to the grounds is the back gate on Fairground Rd. Horsemen will then be stopping for a check in process like has been done in the past. If paperwork is not complete, horsemen will not gain access to the grounds. Please follow the signs.

If you did not submit Coggins for the horses that were listed on your racing application, please email, regular mail or fax these as soon as possible. Horsemen that have not submitted Coggins will be denied entry to the draw box. EHV and health certificate may be submitted at the gate. All required paperwork must be turned in or you will be denied entrance to the grounds.

We will once again be providing straw for bedding and hay for the horsemen's use. If you choose not to use what is provided, the cost of whatever you use will be at your expense.

Horsemen who are staying on the grounds for the entire meet can request their barn preference on the racing application. The Robbins barn will not be available. **These requests are not guaranteed.** If the same barn is requested by more than one horseman, then names will be drawn for barn assignments.

Campers will only be allowed in the camper parking area. Camper space is limited and must be requested on the racing application when submitted. Spaces will be allotted in the order they are requested. Campers over 28" will not be allowed on the grounds. There are local campgrounds to accommodate the larger campers and overflow.

All purse checks for Shenandoah Downs, including stipend payments, will be made by direct deposit this year. This will be the only method of payment for all owners, trainers and drivers. If you completed the forms previously, **AND NOTHING HAS CHANGED,** you must complete the Purse Authorization form. If you did not complete the W9 form and Direct Deposit forms previously, you must complete them and return them either by email, regular mail or fax. Trainers please make your owners aware of this requirement. Forms are available on our website under the ***Race Meet*** tab.

The Virginia Racing Commission has recently changed the rules concerning the use of Clenbuterol. Please check this change and all medication rules before racing at Shenandoah Downs. A link to the medication withdrawal times can be found on our website on the ***Race Meet*** tab.
